

How do I apostille a document that was notarized by a U.S military notary?

If your document was notarized on a domestic or foreign military base by a U.S commissioned military notary public you must go through the United States Department of State in Washington D.C to receive a federal apostille or authentication certificate on the document.

This is because **all U.S military notaries are commissioned by the FEDERAL government, not the State of Texas or any of the other 50 states.**

If however, you had a commissioned Texas notary public travel to a military base in Texas to perform the notary on your documents, then you can go through the Texas Secretary of State and hire us to rush obtain a Texas apostille certificate on your document. This is because all licensed Texas notaries are commissioned by the TEXAS government.
