

What if my documents need to be translated before I get them apostilled or authenticated?

If you need a document translated before you get it apostilled, you will need to hire a Texas notary public (it cannot be a notary from any other state or country) to witness the translator who translated your documents sign the translation documents. The translator signed NOT YOU.

The **original document being translated would need to be submitted to us** along with a properly notarized translated document copy to be apostilled by the State of Texas.

Please note the Texas public notary CANNOT also be the translator on your documents (sometimes a translator is also a licensed notary public), you must have two separate people (Texas notary public + translator) sign your translator documents.
